Since 1998, the Foundation, run by volunteers, has worked to fulfill Kyle's dream by supporting children and their families during difficult times. We provide memorable experiences, respite, and accommodation, ensuring they receive the support they need.

Kyle lost his battle with cancer at age 11 after attending the first Kyle's Camp, but his legacy lives on through the Foundation. Today, we continue to honor his vision, making a difference in the lives of children and families facing immense challenges.

The Foundation relies on donations and fundraising efforts to deliver its programs and services. It is fully incorporated as a registered charity with the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission.

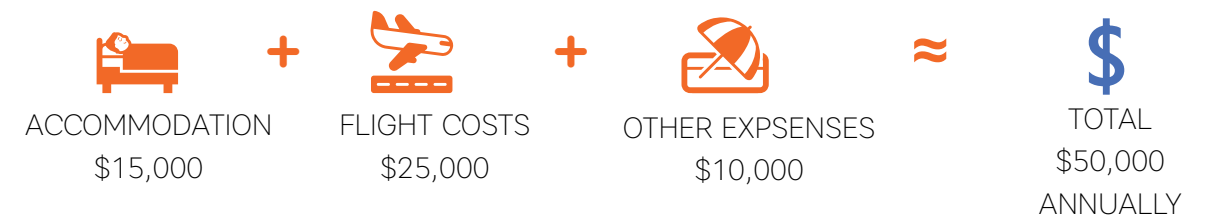

In 1998, Kyle, undergoing treatment for leukaemia, found strength and healing in his hometown of Broome. Recognising that his hospital friends needed the same escape, he dreamed of bringing them to Cable Beach, believing "they might feel better."

The Broome community rallied to make Kyle's dream a reality, raising funds for the first Kyle's Camp in 1998. The experience was so impactful that it became an annual event. The camp offers unforgettable activities, including:

Red Sun camel ride | fishing charter day with AOC | Breakfast and yoga at Cable Beach Club Resort & Spa

Children stay at Broome Camp School on Cable Beach, where they connect with others facing similar challenges. For one week, they are free to be kids again, leaving behind the stress of medical treatments. The joy and resilience we witness at Kyle's Camp are a testament to the power of community and the lasting impact of Kyle's vision.

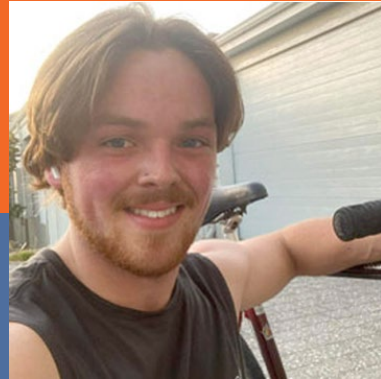

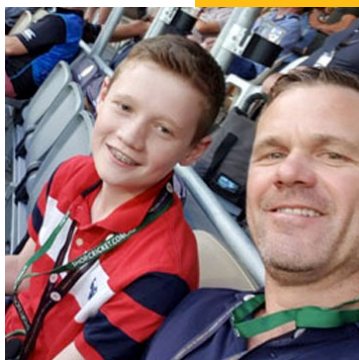


TESTIMONIALS
